OBOE SOLOIST STEPHEN CAPLAN and CARSON CHAMBER SINGERS TO PERFORM WITH SYMPHONY

The Carson City Symphony, directed by David Bugli, will present a Science & Wonder concert on Sunday, April 29, 4:00 p.m. at the Carson City Community Center, 851 E. William Street. Guest soloist Stephen Caplan, Professor of Oboe at UNLV and Principal Oboist of the Las Vegas Philharmonic and Sierra Winds, will be featured in Concerto No. 2 for Oboe and Orchestra by Sir William Herschel, a noted astronomer as well as a composer.

Judy Monson will conduct the Carson Chamber Singers and the Symphony in "How Lovely is Thy Dwelling Place" from A German Requiem by Johannes Brahms and "The Heavens are Telling" from The Creation by Franz Josef Haydn.



The concert opens with the beginning of "Also Sprach Zarathustra" by Richard Strauss, the main theme for the sciencefiction movie 2001: A Space Odyssey. The program also includes "Oblivion" by Astor Piazzola, "Polovtsian Dances" from the opera Prince Igor by the Russian composer Alexander Borodin, who was a talented chemist, and "O Magnum Mysterium" by Morten Lauridsen.


