The Carson City Symphony invites you to a concert on Sunday, March 1, at 4:00 p.m. at the Carson City Community



Center, 801 E. William St., Carson City. This exciting program celebrates eight seasons: The Four Seasons by Antonio Vivaldi and The Four Seasons in Buenos Aires by Astor Piazzolla. Both are directed by David Bugli and feature guest violin soloist Stephanie Sant'Ambrogio and narrator Rita Geil. STRAZZ youth strings will join the orchestra in Vivaldi's Autumn and Winter.

The program also includes Ralph Vaughan Williams' English Folk Song Suite for woodwinds,

brass and percussion, conducted by Stephen Anthenien.

Pre-concert entertainment by the **Regency Strings**—

violinist Cecilia Twain and bassist George Worth-begins at 3:00 p.m. in the lobby.

A meet-the-soloist preview, hosted by Music Director David Bugli, will include discussions with Stephanie



Sant'Ambrogio, Rita Geil, and Stephen Anthenien about the concert, composers, and music. The preview begins at 3:15 p.m. in the Sierra Room.

Stephanie Sant'Ambrogio is an internationally acclaimed performing artist who has recorded more than 75 CDs. She is Director of the Orchestral Career Studies Graduate Program and Associate Professor of Violin and Viola at the University of Nevada, Reno, a member of the Argenta Trio, and Artistic Director of Cactus Pear Music Festival in San Antonio, Texas.

The 2014-15 concert season is supported with public funding through the Nevada Arts Council and the National Endowment for the Arts. The Symphony's youth strings are funded in part by a grant from Partnership Carson City, and pre-concert talks by Nevada Humanities.

Tickets are \$15 general admission; \$12 for seniors, students, and Symphony Association members; and free for youth age 16 and under.
