For its first concert in 2018, the Carson City Symphony presents *Crosscurrents* on Sunday, February 25, 4:00 p.m., at the Bob Boldrick Theater in the Carson City Community Center, 851 E. William Street.

Guest soloist is **Stephen Framil,** in his fourth appearance with the Carson City Symphony, will perform the dramatic Cello Concerto No. 2 by Victor Herbert. Dr. Framil is an internationally renowned cello soloist, Music Director and Conductor of Camerata Philadelphia, and Artistic Director of the Port City Music Festival in North Carolina.



The program also includes *La Suerte de Los Tontos* (Fortune of Fools) by Johnny Richards (Juan Manuel Cascales), Selections from "Slavonic Dances," Op. 46, by Antonín Dvořák, the *Karelia Suite* by Jean Sibelius, and *Quadrophenia* by Pete Townshend.

cellist Evan Stern - begins at 3:00 p.m.

Stephen Framil will lead an Artist-in-Residence workshop and masterclass for cellists of all ages on Thursday, February 22, from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. at the Carson High Band Room. It is free and open to the public. All participants will be given complimentary family tickets to the concert.

Dr. Framil and Lou Groffman, Principal Cellist of the Carson City Symphony and Symphony Youth Strings Instructor, will perform a duet. He will play excerpts from the solo cello part of the concerto and discuss its history, style, and composer.
