It's a Holiday Treat for all – a feast of seasonal and holiday entertainment in many styles! The Carson City Symphony presents the 34th annual Holiday Treat concert on Sunday, Dec. 10, 4:00 p.m., at the Bob Boldrick Theater in the Carson City Community Center, 851 E. William Street.

The Symphony will be joined by the Carson City Symphony Chorus and the Victorian Dancers. Pre-concert entertainment by STRAZZ, our advanced youth strings ensemble, begins at 3:00 p.m. in the lobby. STRAZZ will play music from the *American String Quartet*



by Antonín Dvorák.

The Carson City Symphony, conducted by Music Director-Conductor David Bugli, will perform several works, including *The Bells of Christmas*, "Dance of the Tumblers" from *The Snow Maiden*, and *Festive Sounds of Hanukah*. The Carson City Symphony Chorus, directed by Michael Langham, will join with the Symphony for Gwyneth Walker's *Rejoice!* and Conrad Susa's *A Christmas Garland*.

The Victorian Dancers, choreographed by Tiffany Alm and directed by Sonja Radig, will whirl and swirl to the sound of Scott Joplin's *Bethena Rag-time Waltz* and Leroy Anderson's familiar favorite, *Sleigh Ride*. Performers and audience will join together for the traditional Holiday Treat finale, *A Christmas Singalong*.
