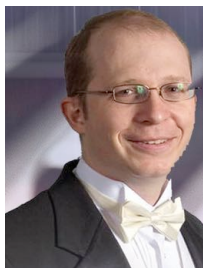


Concert with Alexander Tutunov

APRIL CONCERT FEATURES PIANIST ALEXANDER TUTUNOV and VIOLINISTS BRIAN FOX and ERIC STERN

The Carson City Symphony, directed by David Bugli, will feature pianist **Alexander Tutunov** on Sunday, April 29, 2018, at the Carson City Community Center's Bob Boldrick Theater, 851 E. William Street in Carson City. Dr. Tutunov will perform Beethoven's Piano Concerto No. 3. The concert will also showcase Symphony musicians **Brian Fox**, Concertmaster, and **Eric Stern**, Principal Violist



(playing violin), in a performance of Vivaldi's Concerto for Two Violins in A minor.

The program also includes Rossini's *Semiramide* Overture, and two movements from Elana Roussanova Lucas' *Tatarian Dances* (Harvest Dance and Wedding Dance).

Pre-show entertainment in the lobby by the Symphony Flute Duo (Carol Grenier and Edith Isidoro-Mills) begins at 3:00 p.m.

Tickets are \$15 general admission; \$12 for seniors, students, and Symphony Association members; and free for youth age 18 and under. Tickets are available in advance at the Nevada Day Store, 716 N. Carson Street; online at CCSymphony.com; and at the door.

CONSORT CANZONA EARLY MUSIC INSTRUMENTAL ENSEMBLE AND JOYFUL NOISE CARSON CHILDREN'S CHOIR IN CONCERT APRIL 21

Consort Canzona Early Music Instrumental Ensemble and the Joyful Noise Carson Children's Choir will perform a free concert on Saturday, April 21, 7:00 p.m., at Shepherd of the Sierra Lutheran Church, 3680 Highway 395 (just south of Best Buy). Admission is free, donations welcome.

The concert includes a demonstration of Consort Canzona instruments. The Children's Choir, directed by Nancy Jones and accompanied by Liz Hastings, will present four "Songs About Rainbows." Consort Canzona will play instrumental versions of several short pieces of music from the 1200s to the 1700s.

"MUSIC IS FOR LIFE" CONCERT APRIL 26 AT COMMUNITY CENTER

Carson City Symphony's Youth Strings ensembles and Not Quite Ready For Carnegie Hall Players (adult intermediate string ensemble) will perform a "Music is for Life (goes to the movies)" concert on Thursday, April 26, 6:30 p.m., at the Carson City Community Center, 851 E. William Street. They will present themes from movies including James Bond, *The Sound of Music*, *Spartacus*, and *To Kill a Mockingbird*, and other tunes. Admission is free.

The concert features performances by students grades 2 through high school, including beginning violins and cellos; the Allegro, Vivace, and STRAZZ youth strings ensembles; the adult ensemble; and special guests.

Dr. Tutunov will lead a Masterclass for local pianists of all ages. The class on Saturday, April 28, will begin at 2:00 p.m., onstage at the Carson City Community Center. It is free for participants and observers and open to the public. Pianists who wish to be active participants need to call the Symphony at 775-883-4154.

Widely recognized as one of the most outstanding virtuosos of the former Soviet Union, Tutunov performs in Europe, China, Mexico, and the United States as a recitalist, soloist with orchestra, and on radio and television. He is Professor of Music, Director of Keyboard Studies, and Artist in Residence at Southern Oregon University and is also in demand as an adjudicator for piano competitions.
